

The BCBLC Bible Instructor Training offers supervised, comprehensive Bible instructor training leading to BCBLC Bible Instructor certification and an opportunity to be enlisted in the BCBLC International Registry of Certified Bible Instructors and Bible Instructor Coordinators. Upon completion of the self-paced BCBLC Bible Instructor Training program, participants receive a certificate representing the satisfactory completion of four Modules under the collaborative supervision of BCBLC and a qualified Seventh-day Adventist Ministry Coach. Between Modules (preferably Modules 2 and 3), participants will experience interactive field work pertaining to the various aspects of Bible Instructor Ministry. The BCBLC Bible Instructor Training includes, but is not limited to:

## **BEST PRACTICES OF BIBLE INSTRUCTOR PROFESSIONALS**

Incorporate the theoretical and experiential principles and qualities of effective and productive Bible work to lifestyle standards and co-laboring with God in a professional manner.

## **THE SPIRITUAL DYNAMICS OF EVANGELISM**

Demonstrate understanding spiritual dynamics of venue-specific evangelism and essential Bible work functions necessary to support soul-winning efforts of local churches and community-wide evangelistic campaigns.

## **FLEXIBLE ROLES OF BIBLE INSTRUCTORS IN EVANGELISM**

Recognize and conform to appropriate interrelations among Bible workers, Bible instructors, Bible instructor coordinators and pastor/evangelists, that promotes unity and team effort in the soul-winning process.

## **THE BIBLE INSTRUCTOR MINISTRY OF SOUL-WINNING**

Learn and apply soul-winning strategies for establishing friendship ministries, effective outreach, the art and science of to-the-heart Bible teaching for spiritual and lifestyle conversions, and progressive appeals that result in baptisms.

## **STUDY STRATEGIES AND APPLICATION OF BIBLE PRINCIPLES FOR SOUL-WINNING**

Build upon sound doctrinal grounding for sharing SDA beliefs, continuous spiritual growth through dedicated a prayer life, and addressing testing truths, situational challenges, and making progressive appeals.

## BCBLC BIBLE INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

<b>Information Required for Certification</b>	<p>A certificate of completion is awarded Bible Instructor Training participants who have verified completion of all independent and supervised activities (by a Ministry Coach) in all <b>FOUR MODULES</b>, and full participation in each <b>MODULE LECTURE</b>. Because of the extensive field and hands-on activities required, training is expected to take a minimum of one year.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Create a binder for all written work. <i>Microsoft Office Word</i> (format, Times Roman, 12 pt font, 1.5 line space) is recommended (but not required).</li> <li>2. Provided forms in this workbook must be copied and used with activities.</li> <li>3. The <b>Assignment and Activity Completion Checklist</b>, signed off by your Ministry Coach and BCBLC Representative must be submitted to BCBLC.</li> </ol>
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<b>Ministry Coach</b>	<p>A qualified <b>Ministry Coach</b> must complete a <b>Ministry Coach Commitment Form</b> and be approved by BCBLC administration.</p> <p>The Bible Instructor participant may choose a Seventh-day Adventist pastor, experienced elder in Bible work, or an experienced Head Bible Instructor of a SDA church to be their Ministry Coach. The Ministry Coach must have enough experience as a soul-winner to properly supervise, advise, provide opportunities for, partner with and evaluate Module training as necessary. Requests may be submitted to replace a Ministry Coach, or to suspend training until an appropriate Ministry Coach can be secured.</p>
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<b>Field Work and other Assignments</b>	<p>In addition to independent workbook activities and four <b>MODULE LECTURES</b>, all forms will be provided and required for work with Ministry Coach, recording observations, outreach activity, collecting Bible study <i>friend</i> data, logging Bible studies, local church and public evangelistic involvement, baptisms, new member nurturing, etc.</p>
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<b>Module Lecture Attendance</b>	<p>Attending all four <b>MODULE LECTURES</b> is <u>required</u>. It is recommended, but not required, to complete the <b>MODULES</b> in consecutive order. <b>MODULES</b> are offered annually at PELC, but may be held at other locations. Credit will not be given for partial attendance of a <b>MODULE LECTURE</b>.</p>

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## ABOUT THE FACILITATOR

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Gloria J. Bell, PH.D.

Forever embedded in Gloria Bell's memory is the role of those visibly active and inspirational Bible Instructors in Oakland, California who, in the early 1950s, changed the trajectory of her mother's life, and as a result, her own life. Years later, from the onset of their 40+ year ministry in South Central and Southern California conferences, soul-winning quickly became the norm for her teacher summers as an assumed expectation of her husband and pastor, Richard Bell (now deceased). Thanks to seasoned Bible Instructors like Dr. Mildred Johnson who modeled the way, Gloria has been blessed to lead hundreds to a life in Christ. For her, there has been no greater honor than laboring with God for re-directing life trajectories with eternity in view.

Reflecting on her Bible Instructor ministry, Gloria Bell has been privileged to serve numerous pastors and campaigns as Bible Instructor, campaign coordinator, Bible Instructor training facilitator and speaker. You may recognize names of evangelists, such as: S.J. Jackson, R. Stafford, H. Small, O. Lane, J. Wilson, M. Johns, C. Byrd, M. Ross, E. Peeler, R. Pollard, and others, including from the General Conference: M. Finley, D. Baker, and S. Boonstra. Her book, *Help for the Harvest* is, to a great degree, a manual dedicated to preserving the high calling of soul-winning through Bible Instructor ministry.

An Education and Mathematics graduate of Oakwood University, she continued academically at Jackson State and Southwest universities earning a M.S. in Adult Education (1979) and Ph.D. in Administrative Studies (2001), respectively. Over the years God has blessed her gifts as an educator, IBM facilitator and technology administrator for United Way and the Urban League to encourage the best in people from all walks of life to the glory of God. She is currently the Academic Advisor for the Adult and Continuing Education's LEAP program at Oakwood University and is a member of New Life SDA Church in Huntsville, Alabama, where she serves as an elder, Personal Ministries and Bible Instructor Coordinator.

God's most precious gifts to her are her three children and their families (including five grandsons). May this series bring each of us into closer union with God for the salvation of precious souls while preserving the professional and inspirational dignity of the Bible Instructor.

Bible Instructors are in the *healing and restoring heart ministry*, commissioned and ordained by God in Matthew 28:19-20, Acts 1:8, 2Corinthians 5:18-20, etc., and go forth as bold ambassadors of Christ and the Kingdom of God, introducing households to spiritual freedom in Christ Jesus, their higher calling and eternal inheritance. Every precious one is a personal *friend for eternity*, providently positioned for salvation through the divinely-appointed guidance of the Bible Instructor in the God-chosen season of their life. 
**THE BI’S EFFORT MUST BE INTENSE**

## REASONS TO USE ILLUSTRATIONS

- Reminds hearer that you have a backstory too.
- You can relate to their backstory (and overcame)
- It arouses spiritual sensitivity.
- Raises hope that they can believe in and trust God.
- Raises faith in God to stay the course.
- Living testimony of the joy of the Christian life.

Only God can turn

**message**, a **TEST** into a  
**testimony**, a **TRIAL** into  
a **triumph**, a **VICTIM**  
into a **victory**.

## USING ILLUSTRATIONS POWERFULLY

- Keep it brief.
- Be a keen listener
- Make sure it relates to the immediate point of discussion.
- Don't give too many.
- Allow for your *friend's* to testify.
- Make your point salvific.
- Share it sincerely and in love.
- Appeal to ensure points are clear.

## ILLUSTRATION RESOURCES

**Your illustrations can add powerfully in clarifying and convicting. They can be...**

- Your own personal experience/testimony
- A biblical event
- An embellished experience
- Experiences told you by others
- Experiences read or researched
- Clichés, proverbs, old sayings, etc.
- Pictorial or dramatic

**Multitudes have a wrong conception of God and are as truly serving a false god as were the worshipers of Baal {SS 94.1**


Ask the following question whenever unbelief rises:

Multitudes have a wrong conception of God and are as truly serving a false god as were the worshipers of Baal. Many even of those who claim to be Christians have allied themselves with influences that are unalterably opposed to God and His truth. {SS 94.1} Ask the following questions. Not for argument, but as a starting point for presenting the truth about God.

## TWO QUESTIONS WE MUST ASK OURSELVES

**Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me...Then I will teach transgressors your ways, and sinners will return to you. Psalm 51:10-13**



## CHRIST TAUGHT BUILDING RELATIONSHIPS

During His earthly ministry Christ began to break down the partition wall between Jew and Gentile, and to preach salvation to all mankind. Though He was a Jew,

- He mingled freely with the Samaritans, setting at naught the Pharisaic customs of the Jews with regard to this despised people.
- He slept under their roofs, ate at their tables, and **taught** in their streets. AA, 19.2

## WIDER, HIGHER BEYOND IMAGINATION

Use every Bible study opportunity to take your *friends for eternity* to a place in God's love that is wider, higher, and beyond their imagination AND can never be satisfied by worldly effort.

**God has a greater plan and Purpose far beyond your Imagination.**

## EXPECTANCY MUST BECOME CHRIST-CENTERED

### God has a plan

- Jeremiah 29:11 For I know the plans I have for you.

### God will use our lives to fulfill His plan

## EFFECTIVE TEACHING PRINCIPLES

1. Be quickly observant and hear.
2. Use positive body language.
3. Note only two or three points, don't rush.
4. **Do not assume. Answer potential objections.**
5. Complement.
6. Correct answers may NOT mean correct understanding.
7. Write the answers in their own words.
8. Pause to ask questions for clarity.
9. Give clarifying biblical examples, and brief personal experiences.
10. Appeal throughout and pray.

- There might be someone else in the house or neighborhood you can connect with.
- Go on another day or at another time.
- Reiterate some benefits of attendance (or studying together). (pg. 114)





## TESTING TRUTHS

**Testing Truths** are doctrines that will challenge currently held belief systems.

Keep in mind the Ellen White statement: “When they surrender heart and mind and will to God, they are then prepared candidly to weigh evidence in regard to these solemn testing truths (EV, 485).

By all means, do not present testing truths until you are reasonably certain the person has been converted—surrendered his/her life to Christ and longs to know God’s will.

Do not use testing truths in pursuing \_\_\_\_\_.

**Remember the sage adage:**

“Persons convinced against their will are of the \_\_\_\_\_.”

*Difficult truths* are topics easily misunderstood by the BI and therefore too often taught in error to Bible study interests. For this reason, they can become a turn-off and should be avoided under most circumstances. Emphasis must focus on a heart-surrender to Jesus Christ. **Stay Focused!**

- Whether the spirit of the dead go straight to heaven or hell
- The location of hell
- The rapture of the saints
- Whether the millennial period is before or after the second coming
- The tribulation period.

- Who is Michael the archangel
- Time prophecies
- America in Bible prophecy
- The mark of the beast and seal of God, and other Daniel and Revelation topics
- Speaking in tongues, etc.

**Let the Holy Spirit correct these as their \_\_\_\_\_ with God GROWS**

## RESPONSE TO ELLEN G. WHITE AND CULTS

A Christian cult will deny one or more of the fundamental truths of Christianity while still claiming to be Christian. The two most common teachings of Christian cults are that \_\_\_\_\_ was not God and that \_\_\_\_\_ is not by faith alone.

The two most well-known examples of cults today are the Jehovah's Witnesses and Mormons. Both groups claim to be Christian, yet both deny the deity of Christ and salvation by faith alone.

- *Seventh-day* Adventists are *back-to-the-Bible Christians*. Notably, we believe the seventh-day is still God's holy Sabbath (Isaiah 58:13), promote a healthy lifestyle (1Corinthians 6:19-20), and look forward to Christ's soon return (Revelation 1:7).
- Ellen G. White was one of the founders of the Seventh-day Adventist Church. She received divine visions and was the prolific author of over 40 books and thousands of articles, translated in more languages than any other female author.

- Can Quickly Halt All Progress.
- Used by Satan to Confuse.
- Could have a Domino Effect.

- Reiterate some benefits of studying together.
- Leave the home with the *friend* loving God

## WHY AVOIDANCE BEHAVIOR

- Desire to maintain old traditions/habits
- Negative feedback from valued family and friends
- Being shunned by pastor/church, friends and/or family
- Isolated lifestyle

- God will hold them responsible for new learnings/understanding
- God cannot be trusted
- Too much emphasis on works
- Not absolutely sure of truth
- Stereotypes/fake facts about SDAs

Avoidance is not necessarily because of unbelief, but could be because of the above factors. Ask the \_\_\_\_\_ questions and address these REAL/STALL objections.
